## FOOD & CLOTHING ASSISTANCE

The Sunshine Division offers emergency food & clothing assistance six days a week at our North Portland warehouse as well as 24/7 through our partnership with the Portland Police Bureau who store food boxes at each police precinct that can be dispatched at any time. Our programs include:

- Free on-site food and clothing stores
- Food bank providing bulk food donations at no cost to 15 area nonprofits
- Emergency food boxes at each Portland Police precinct & area law enforcement agencies
- Summer food box delivery program
- Thanksgiving food box program
- Holiday food box delivery program



Our food store allows clients to 'shop'  
for the food that best suits their  
household.



### DID YOU KNOW:

Sunshine Division received a 4 out of 4 star rating from Charity Navigator two years in a row.

Over \$.94 of every dollar donated goes directly to food and clothing assistance programs.

Almost 500 children a year "shop with a cop" for new school clothes paid for by Sunshine Division.

Each year Portland Police Officers deliver 1,000 food boxes to Portlanders who are hungry and unable to leave their homes.

The Sunshine Division assists in distributing over 1.4 million pounds of bulk food to area nonprofits, serving more than 100,000 individuals a year.
