

ORDINANCE NO. 186542

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to accept \$20,000 for funds to assist the City's Office of Equity & Human Rights in hosting the 2014 Governing for Racial Equity Conference (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Whereas, the City seeks to be a leader in efforts to address racial equity, not only in Portland, but throughout the region;
2. Whereas, the City's Office of Equity & Human Rights is a founding member of the Governing for Racial Equity (GRE) network;
3. Whereas, the City's Office of Equity & Human Rights is the lead Portland agency for hosting the 2014 GRE Conference;
4. Whereas, Multnomah County and other GRE partners require formal agreements for GRE Conference contributions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to enter into an IGA to accept \$20,000 from Multnomah County to assist with the 2014 Governing for Racial Equity Conference.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because all of the conference expenses have been paid out by the Office of Equity and Human Rights by using its funds as well as the sponsorship monies received from King County and City of Seattle. Multnomah County's funds are the last remaining to be received and credited for the conference. Waiting until possibly the end of June to be able to account for the funds would place a burden on the city's accounting system to close the books prior to the end of the fiscal year; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
