ORDINANCE No. 186545

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount \$32,000 from The Oregon Community Foundation for the costs of installing a drainage system and foundation waterproofing at the Hillside Community Center site (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds

- 1. Portland Parks & Recreation applied to The Oregon Community Foundation for a Northwest Neighborhoods Parks & Rec Fund grant in the amount to \$32,500 on November 1, 2013 for the installation of a drainage system and foundation waterproofing;
- 2. OCF has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant in the amount of \$32,000 for installing a drainage system and foundation waterproofing at the Hillside Community Center;
- 3. Hillside Community Center, which is located in a densely populated NW Portland neighborhood, provides a preschool program for 50 families with children between the ages of 2 and 5 years old. A dedicated preschool classroom space on the southwest lower level floods regularly during heavy rains, including 8 incidences in 2012/2013. Flooding negatively impacts the Community Center's ability to serve families, leading to class cancellations as well as increased expenditures for equipment replacement. The building repairs will help to eliminate flooding and service cancellation.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Portland, a grant in the amount of \$32,000 from the Oregon Community Foundation for the installation of drainage systems and foundation waterproofing at Hillside Community Center.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

c. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation is authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Portland, any subsequent modifications by The Oregon Community Foundation for the grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
