ORDINANCE No. 186555

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Port of Portland for reconstruction, maintenance and repair of a portion of NE Mt. Hood Ave. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. NE Mt. Hood Avenue is a private roadway owned and operated by the Port of Portland. A small segment of NE Mt. Hood Avenue described in Exhibit B is City of Portland right-of-way.
- 2. The Port of Portland is reconstructing NE Mt. Hood Avenue including the portion in the City of Portland right-of-way.
- 3. This agreement will permit the Port of Portland to work in the City right-of-way and to establish maintenance obligations.
- 4. All work will be constructed and funded by the Port of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Port of Portland in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Port of Portland is planning to begin construction soon; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
