The City is responsible for operations and maintenance of the new at-grade roadway crossing in accordance with ODOT Crossing Orders 50980 and 51050. Funding for future maintenance is expected to come from General Transportation Revenues. The City currently has maintenance responsibility for the existing at-grade crossings in this vicinity so the impact of future operations and maintenance is anticipated to be negligible.

TriMet is responsible for construction costs and will pay a \$500 administrative handling charge to the Railroad upon return of the executed Supplemental Agreement.
