TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 116346 for the Interstate 5 at SW 26<sup>th</sup> Water Quality Facilities Project for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of \$2,600,000.00. The Bureau of Environmental Services rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on March 18, 2014, and Seven (7) bids were received. The low bid of Tapani, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation, and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$2,125.604.40.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified nine (9) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$395,337.34 awarded to subcontractors.

In their bid Tapani, Inc. indicated their intent to self-perform the following divisions of work:

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
