

ORDINANCE No. 186566

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$3,850 and appropriate \$1,500 for FY 2013-14 from Oregon Impact for the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Police Bureau applied to Oregon Impact for a grant in the amount of \$5,300 for the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program on March 3, 2014; and
2. Oregon Impact has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$3,850; and
3. The Police Bureau Traffic Division will participate in the program by enforcing vehicle code sections involving pedestrian right of way in crosswalks and educating citizens about the causes of pedestrian crashes; and
4. Oregon Impact will reimburse the City a maximum of \$3,850 for sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program; and
5. The local match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided from City funds in the form of Traffic Division straight time hours in support of pedestrian safety enforcement in the Police Bureau's FY 2013-14 and FY 2014-15 budgets. The estimated match is \$3,434; and
6. The bureau's grant period is May 22, 2014, through September 30, 2014; and
7. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from Oregon Impact.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Oregon Impact for the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program in the amount of \$3,850.
- b. The FY 2013-14 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL

Bureau Program Expenses - \$1,500

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
  - d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by Oregon Impact for the 2014 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement program, PS-14-68-02, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from Oregon Impact. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


