

ORDINANCE No. 186568

Authorize a contract with Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. to provide mental health services through Project Respond (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare, Inc. currently provides three Qualified Mental Health Professionals to ride along with uniformed police officers in patrol cars to provide on-scene mental health assessment and evaluation as part of the Behavioral Health Unit.
2. This partnership provides linkage to social service resources and uses the Raintree database to identify and follow up with individuals who are generating frequent police contact due to a mental health or emotional crisis.
3. A similar contract has existed between the City and Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare since 2011 and has been amended twice. In the past, the contract has been funded by one-time funding decided on a fiscal year to fiscal year basis. The funding is now ongoing.
4. The City and Cascadia Behavioral Healthcare wish to enter into a new one-year contract that reflects the current program for these services beginning July 1, 2014.
5. The value of the contract would be not to exceed amount of \$265,054.
6. This sole source contract is being acquired as an exception to the competitive selection process identified in PCC 5.68 and the PTE Services Contracting Manual.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
