*Create a new Nonrepresented classification of Assistant Deputy City Attorney, which is exempt from the classified service, and establish a compensation rate for this classification. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating a new Nonrepresented classification, effective March 13, 2014.
- 2. A critical element of this classification is acting as a deputy of the City Attorney.
- 3. Accordingly, the Director of the Bureau of Human Resources recommends that employees hired into this classification shall be excluded from the classified service, as provided by the City Charter and Human Resources Administrative Rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The following classification is being created:

b. Employees hired into this classification shall be excluded from the classified service.
