The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional engineering services for the Fremont Wastewater Pump Station Upgrade, Project No. E10543.
- 2. Consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP BES147). The consultant selection committee recommends that BergerABAM, Inc. be retained to provide the required professional engineering services.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$239,730. Level of confidence is high. M/W/ESB participation is \$82,646 or 34.5% of the total contract amount. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget Project No. E10543.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with BergerABAM, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$239,730.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
