ORDINANCE No. 186594

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office to provide inmate work crews to the City of Portland in the not-to-exceed annual amount of \$150,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Maintenance Operations section routinely finds itself in need of casual labor services provided by inmate work crews. The services as provided are mutually beneficial to both the City of Portland and Multnomah County.
- 2. Cost of services shall be \$565.00 for each day of service provided by Multnomah County's inmate work crews. The charge covers the cost of a supervising deputy and transport truck/trailer. The crews are 5-8 inmates working 8-hour days including travel time. Annual cost will be a not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000.
- 3. Term of this Agreement shall begin on July 1, 2014 and will terminate on June 30, 2019.
- 4. Multnomah County provides similar services to other governmental agencies.
- 5. Service level provided in the past has been exemplary and a good value for the taxpayers of the City of Portland.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is optimal.
- 7. The Office of Management and Finance/Facilities Services recommends that the attached Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office for inmate work crews for casual labor services, substantially in conformance with Exhibit A, in the not-to-exceed annual amount of \$150,000 be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office, substantially in accordance with Exhibit A attached.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the appropriate fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the implementation of the Agreement will cause scheduling delays in anticipated projects during the crucial summer/fall work periods; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
