7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Attached is an ordinance to authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) to provide inmate work crews to the City of Portland.

The Maintenance Operations section routinely finds itself in need of casual labor services provided by inmate crews. The services as provided are mutually beneficial to both the City of Portland and Multnomah County. Multnomah County provides similar services to other governmental agencies. Service level provided in the past has been exemplary and a good value for the taxpayers of the City of Portland.

Cost of services under this agreement shall be \$565.00 for each day of service provided by the MCSO's inmate work crews. The charge covers the cost of a supervising deputy and transport truck/trailer. The crews are 5-8 inmates working 8-hour days including travel time.

Term of the agreement shall begin on July 1, 2014 and will terminate on June 30, 2019.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

This Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office to provide inmate work crews to the City of Portland will be a not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000 annually. Total expense over the five year term will not exceed \$750,000.

The total annual cost of this Agreement is included in the budget for fiscal year 2014-15.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

It is recommended that Council approve this Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office to provide inmate work crews to the City of Portland in the not-to-exceed annual amount of \$150,000.

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
