

ORDINANCE NO. 186597

* Authorize application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for a grant in the amount of \$473,000 for Phase 1 development of the Cully Park Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is soliciting projects for grant funding under the Local Government Grants program, which provides project funding for the development of outdoor recreation facilities.
2. Portland Parks and Recreation (PP&R) is seeking funding through this Local Government Grants Program to develop the playground, the off-leash dog area, the overlooks, the walking trails, and the North Slope Habitation Restoration at the Cully Park site. This will improve access to developed and natural recreational areas in the area. 405 households who currently do not have easy access to a park or natural area (defined a half-mile walk) will benefit from Thomas Cully Park.
3. Local match in the amount of \$271,512 will be provided by funds from systems development charges.
4. Verde have raised \$471,488 in support of the project and have applied for additional funds.
5. Portland Parks and Recreation will provide adequate funding for on-going operations and maintenance of this park and recreation facility should grant funds be awarded.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:


- a) The Mayor is authorized to make application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for a grant in the amount of \$473,000.
- b) The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c) The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to apply for the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
