## ORDINANCE No. 186601

Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County District Attorney to reimburse the Police Bureau for overtime costs of officers assigned to the District Attorney Office as investigators (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 52562)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau has an agreement with the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office (MCDA) to provide three officers to perform investigations for the DA.
- 2. The officers participate in investigations directly and indirectly related to the prosecution of crimes within Multnomah County's jurisdiction.
- 3. The City and the MCDA wish to extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2015.
- 4. The City will continue to bill the MCDA quarterly for the equivalent of 7.3 hours of overtime for each of the officers per pay period. The maximum amount to be received under this agreement for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 is \$32,507.58.
- 5. The amendment will be effective July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 unless otherwise extended or terminated.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. C52562 (Multnomah County contract number 4400000919) in a form substantially in agreement with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.


