



- Khabarovsk has been a Portland Sister City for 26 years
- Khabarovsk is the Regional Capital of Russian Far East
- Khabarovsk is Russia's inland port where the Amur River borders with China & connects with the Ussuri River



- PKSCA works in the Khabarovsk territory to address important environmental issues.
- Here PKSCA representatives meet with young Pioneers at a site near Komsomolsk-na-Amur
- The Pioneers are trying to prevent cancer-causing mine tailings from blowing into their community below.



- Technology transfer is a big part of PKSCA's environmental programs.
- Two chemists from the Khabarovsk Vodokanal (Water Company) learn to operate new analytical equipment
- The equipment was used in a quick response to an upstream chemical spill to Khabarovsk's water supply in 2004



- PKSCA's Russian partners are as interested in our ecological systems as our technology
- Here Vladimir Sidorov views the impoundment in Portland's Bull Run watershed.
- The public's accessibility to our utility infrastructure is surprising to many of our Russian partners.



- Mutare is home to the Mutare Museum, the Utopia House Museum dedicated to Kingsley Fairbridge, the National Gallery of Zimbabwe, Murahwa Hill (known for its rock paintings and Iron Age village), Cross Kopje with a memorial to Zimbabweans and Mozambicans killed in World War I and a nature reserve.



- PMSCA works to promote good will and the exchange of ideas, goods, culture and friendship between the people of Portland, Oregon and Mutare, Zimbabwe.



- We strive to learn from our differences, celebrate our similarities and nurture our interconnectedness.



- Over the years, Portland's efforts in Mutare have focused on teaching new techniques for agriculture, ongoing support for educational needs and orphan education, development of a health clinic and empowerment of people living with HIV/AIDS.

The **Portland-Sapporo Sister City Association** is the organization that stewards the longest-running Sister City relationship in Portland, Oregon -- and one of the oldest in the United States. With a mission of fostering and promoting cross-cultural understanding between the U.S. and Japan, the Portland-Sapporo Sister City Association was founded in 1959 and celebrated its 50th successful year in 2009.



Portland and Sapporo are similar in many ways, despite being separated by more than 4,000 miles. Northern cities that lie at close to the same latitude, both are relatively young cities of approximately 150 years, with metropolitan populations of close to two million. Both cities enjoy beautiful settings and an appreciation of the outdoors. Both were established by

pioneers -- by loggers and fishermen -- who took good advantage of their respective region's rich natural resources.



- Portland families learn about Korea, in return.



- Inspired by Portland's beauty, the City of Ulsan has modeled numerous public projects after Portland.
 - **Ulsan Grand Park** -- inspired by Washington Park / Forest Park
 - **Ulsan Rose Valley** -- inspired by Portland's Int'l Rose Garden
 - **Ulsan Rose Festival** -- inspired by the Portland Rose Festival
 - **Restoration of the Taehwa River** & development of green belts for pedestrian enjoyment and recreation -- inspired by the Willamette R. in downtown Portland
