#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Attached is an ordinance to authorize an amendment with Geotechnical Resources, Inc. dba GRI in the amount of \$17,000 for the subject project.

Additional geotechnical consultation services are necessary to allow Contractor to complete the ground improvement phase of the project. Additional services included construction supervision during the soil stabilization efforts and for additional scope as required by Bureau of Development Services (BDS).

A sole source contract (30002889) for geotechnical consultation services for the Fire Station 21 and Boathouse project was issued on October 5, 2012.

Amendment No. 1, dated January 30, 2014 increased the contract amount \$12,500 to allow for additional geotechnical observation services.

Amendment No. 2, dated April 7, 2014 extended the contract termination date through July 31, 2014.

### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

This amendment for geotechnical observation services for the Fire Station 21 and Boathouse project will increase the contract amount by \$17,000. Cost of this amendment will not exceed project budget. This will bring the new total Contract value to \$84,500.

The total annual cost of this amendment is included in the Facilities budget for fiscal year 2014-15.

### 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

It is recommended that Council approve this amendment to Contract No. 30002889 with Geotechnical Resources, Inc. dba GRI to provide additional geotechnical observation services for the Fire Station 21 and Boathouse project in the amount of \$17,000.
