## ORDINANCE No. 186617

\*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$1,147,270 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Springwater Trail Gap: SE Umatilla to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. The Bureau of Parks & Recreation has received a Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grant in the amount of \$1,147,270 from the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the Springwater Trail Gap: SE Umatilla to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave in 2013 requiring a local match of \$131,730; and
- 2. The City of Portland (Portland) and Metro have identified the Springwater Corridor Trail as a Regional Trail.
- 3. Portland and Metro have cooperated since 1992 to create over 17 miles of the Springwater Corridor, a multi-use trail.
- 4. The Bureau of Parks & Recreation and Metro have been jointly working to bridge the gap in the Springwater Corridor Trail between SE Umatilla Ave and SE 19<sup>th</sup> Ave and Ochoco St where the existing Springwater Corridor currently ends. Design work is ready to begin on the section from SE Umatilla Ave to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- 5. In 2010 the Bureau of Parks & Recreation and Metro worked collaboratively with the Bureau of Transportation to find ways to bridge the gap in the trail by providing on-street connectivity utilizing an ODOT High Priority Projects (HPP) grant, in the amount of \$654,000 to bridge the gap in the Springwater Trail from the terminus of the east leg at SE 19th Ave and SE Ochoco St to SE Umatilla St and SE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave in the Sellwood Neighborhood. Ordinance No. 184302.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the ODOT for the Springwater Trail Gap: SE Umatilla to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave in the amount of \$1,147,270 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2013/2014 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## GRANTS FUND Fund - 217001 Business Area – PK Bureau Program Expenses – \$1,147,270

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Parks & Recreation of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by ODOT for Springwater Trail Gap: SE Umatilla to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Ave grant, Contracts and Agreements No. 29674, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk by more than 25%. City Attorney's Office review is required prior to acceptance of amendments for determination of whether an ordinance is needed. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk by more than 25% must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
