Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will provide grant funding under the FY 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program;
- 2. The JAG Program supports the purpose areas of law enforcement programs, prosecution programs, prevention and education programs, and technology improvement programs;
- 3. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as applicant and fiscal agent for the disparate municipalities. The City wishes to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham to obligate agency roles and responsibilities;
- 4. The City will, with USDOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse the City of Gresham for the cost of all approved program expenses not to exceed \$62,995; and
- 5. This agreement shall begin July 1, 2014, and extend through September 30, 2017, or until grant funds are exhausted.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
