## ORDINANCE No. 186622

Extend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon City and TriMet for Transit Police services for one year (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001546)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau currently manages Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District (TriMet) Transit Police under Agreement No. 30001665, the "Prime Agreement" between the City and TriMet, executed July 1, 2010, as authorized by Ordinance 184038, and which will expire June 30, 2015.
- 2. The TriMet Transit Police Division includes sworn law-enforcement personnel from the City, City of Beaverton, City of Cornelius, City of Gresham, City of Hillsboro, Port of Portland, City of Tigard, City of Troutdale, City of Milwaukie, City of Tualatin, City of West Linn, City of Forest Grove, City of Lake Oswego, Oregon City, Multnomah County, Washington County and Clackamas County, which are currently provided under subsidiary agreements.
- 3. All of the intergovernmental agreements created from the Prime Agreement expire on June 30, 2015, except for the agreement with Oregon City, attached as Exhibit A.
- 4. This agreement will extend the Oregon City intergovernmental agreement to concur with the Prime Agreement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend an agreement between the City of Portland, TriMet, and Oregon City substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit B.
