ORDINANCE No. 186643

Authorize a contract with CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc., for professional services for the design of the Structural Rehabilitation of Taggart Outfall 30, BES No. E10220 for \$2,563,250 (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional services for the Structural Rehabilitation of Taggart Outfall 30, BES No. E10220.
2. Consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP BES146). The consultant selection committee recommended that CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. be retained to provide the required professional engineering services.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,563,250. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2013-14 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10220.
4. M/W/ESB participation is \$797,710 or 31% of the total contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,563,250.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
