This ordinance will not generate additional revenue. However, it authorizes certain funds to receive loans totaling \$8.1 million from other funds.

Because the amount of the loan will not be known until the year-end close process is well underway, the loan not-to-exceed amounts included in the resolution are conservative (i.e. high). In the fall, during the year-end close process, once the necessary loan amounts and the responsible bureaus' ability to pay are determined, OMF-Accounting will execute the necessary loans. While the loans authorized total \$8.1 million because of the conservative estimates, the expected actual loan amounts are projected to be considerably less. The repayment sources for the loans are the grant receivables and are considered to be very secure.
