ORDINANCE No. 186658

Authorize a contract with HDR Engineering, Inc., for professional services for the design of the SE Interceptor Rehabilitation No. E10030 for \$1,727,430 (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional services for the SE Interceptor Rehabilitation No. E10030.
2. Consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP BES143). The consultant selection committee recommended that HDR Engineering, Inc. be retained to provide the required professional engineering services.
3. The established cost is \$1,727,430. The level of confidence is HIGH. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2013-14 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10030.
4. M/W/ESB participation is \$431,142 or 25% of the total contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with HDR Engineering, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$1,727,430.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

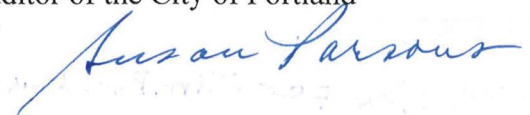

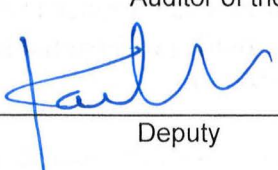
