Public Hearing for consideration of a street vacation request for a portion of SE

Grand Ave – Staff Supplemental Report

4. History of Agenda Item/Background:

A request to vacate a portion of SE Grand Avenue was received by the Bureau of Transportation on May 30, 2013. The street vacation is proposed by Multnomah County in order to address the issue of their existing building that encroaches into the public right-of-way. The County had a lease with ODOT for the encroachment when SE Grand Avenue was under their jurisdiction; however the lease was terminated with the jurisdictional transfer. Rather then have Multnomah County enter into a lease with the City for such a small area, at the request of the County and with the support of ODOT, the City agreed to support vacating the portion of street that the building encroaches into, with the understanding that City Council has final approval. The proposed vacation is depicted on Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

Comments were solicited from City Bureaus, government agencies, public utilities and affected neighborhood associations. No substantive objections were received.

The Planning and Sustainability Commission reviewed and approved the proposed street vacation on March 11, 2014.

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A Revised Engineer's Report was completed on May 7, 2014, recommending approval of the street vacation, subject to certain conditions and reservations. The Report, inclusive of the Planning and Sustainability Commission recommendation, will be forwarded to your office under separate cover, along with a recommended Street Vacation Ordinance for consideration by City Council.

ORS 271.120 requires that a public hearing be held prior to City Council taking action on the street vacation request. This memo is to serve as a formal request to schedule the required public meeting. The Office of the City Auditor will publish and post notice of the scheduled public hearing. The public notice will provide information on how to obtain information about the proposed street vacation, including copies of the Engineer's Report and Planning and Sustainability Commission Recommendation.

The purpose of this request is to schedule a public hearing for consideration of the proposed street vacation request.
