A-1 [070017]	Portland Police Bureau	One special purpose vehicle	The Traffic Division, within the Portland Police Bureau, is requesting to replace a police patrol sedan with a heavy-duty SUV. The mission for the vehicle has changed now requiring supervisors to haul bulky equipment for officer safety and automobile accident investigation. The increased interior capacity of approx. 118 cu ft, payload increase of approx. 1,100 pounds, and climate controlled environment makes the equipment more accessible and protects it from damage. This type of vehicle also becomes a command center for major crashes by allowing command staff room for briefings. Additionally, this vehicle has an 8,200 pound towing capability to tow trailers for motorcycle and ATV transportation. The SUV decreases response time during inclement weather as it is suited for handling harsh driving conditions. The cost of the upgrade is being funded by the Police Bureau budget.
