

ORDINANCE No. 186685

Amend a grant agreement with NAYA for Native-American-specific navigator services at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000977)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 186123, authorized a grant agreement with Grantee after Grantee was selected for grant award based on its response to an invitation.
2. The resulting Grant Agreement No. 32000977 was executed on or about July 1, 2013. The effective date of the Grant Agreement was July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.
3. NAYA has provided excellent advocacy services under the terms of the agreement. The Gateway Center participants benefit from having an Native-American culturally competent advocate.
4. The Center has operational funds to extend the payment for navigator services provided by NAYA until June 30, 2015.
5. The current agreement followed an earlier agreement which began in 2010. There has been no increase in funding since 2010. This amendment provides a 5% increase in funding for the services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to sign the grant amendment with NAYA in substantial conformance with the one attached as Exhibit A and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The grant funding for navigator services in an amount not to exceed \$28,400 will be from the Center's ongoing operations budget.
