Summary of the Proposal







Existing Zoning

Developed with 24,810 sq ft, two story brick clad masonry building, parking area, and a maintenance and storage building.

- SFC Jerome F Sears US Army Reserve Center vacated via the Base Realignment and Closure Programs for Emergency Management Use Program.
- City acquired property Sept 2012, with terms requiring land to be used for emergency management services in perpetuity.



- Portland Bureau of Emergency
 Management identified the City's
 vulnerability to respond to seismic and
 other hazards from the west side,
 particularly if Willamette River bridges
 fail in an event.
- City Council concurs there is a 'compelling public safety need for a west side operations center.'




Aerial View

Hearings Officer Recommendation

- Approval, subject to 3 conditions of approval:
- ► Coordinate with Portland Police Bureau regarding security features for the site.
- ► Retail Sales and Services uses are prohibited.
- ► No more than 80% impervious surfaces developed on the site.
