The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize CityFleet to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Milwaukie for CityFleet to provide repair and maintenance services to the City of Milwaukie on an on-call as-requested basis.

There will be revenues received by the City for performing repair services to the City of Milwaukie; however the revenue source will be variable and funds are received only when services are performed by CityFleet on City of Milwaukie owned vehicles. Per the terms of the IGA, the City of Milwaukie may elect to bring vehicles to City-owned repair facilities and the City would invoice the City of Milwaukie for services rendered. The period of time for this IGA is FY 2014-15 and the labor rate for CityFleet is \$102.88/ hour when indirect costs are included.

The revenue would be collected in the CityFleet fund to pay for the cost of providing the repairs and any parts or services necessary to complete the requested work. This is the same rate that internal and external Fleet customers are charged for this present fiscal year.
