Authorize CityFleet to purchase replacement Police Patrol Vehicles at \$2,332,375 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the Police Patrol Vehicles meet or exceed established criteria.
- 3. It has been determined that eighty (80) patrol vehicles need to be replaced for the Police Bureau - Exhibit A attached.
- 4. The cost of these vehicles is \$2,332,375.68 for eighty patrol vehicles, which is included in FY2013-14 CityFleet replacement budget.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into the contract and any subsequent amendments on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1.
- b. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the contractor chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
