Increase time period for property owners to repair existing driveways to 60 days (Ordinance; amend Code Section 17.28.130)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The time period of 20 days allowed for property owners to complete the repair of hazards identified on a Sidewalk Repair notice is not a realistic and/or adequate period of time.
- 2. This proposal will allow additional time needed to complete the required repairs; receive the notice, contact and schedule a meeting if necessary with the Inspector to understand what is required to remove the hazard(s), get bids from contractors, and secure finances for repair.
- 3. This proposal will change code language from existing 20 days to proposed 60 calendar days to complete repairs for all posted driveway hazards.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

Amend Portland City Code Section 17.28.130, as follows: a.

> If the City Engineer finds that any driveway does not conform to the requirements of this Chapter and should be reconstructed for the protection or convenience of pedestrians or vehicles using the street area, the City Engineer may post notice and require the reconstruction or removal of the driveway. If the abutting property owner fails to make the required corrections within 20 60 days the City may perform the required work at the expense of the abutting property owner, and the cost shall be determined and assessment made as provided in this Chapter.
