## ORDINANCE No. 186722

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for Light Detection and Ranging data and Aerial Photography in an amount of \$280,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City participates in The Regional Aerial Photo Consortium (Consortium), managed by the Metro Data Resource Center, which enables the joint purchase of Aerial Photography, LiDAR data and allied products by Consortium members. The intent of the Consortium is to provide a cost-effective means to acquire these types of products.
- 2. Metro purchases, on behalf of the Consortium, Aerial Photography, LiDAR data and allied products in support of many varied planning, transportation, construction, facility management, land management and related programs and projects. The costs are then prorated among the participating Consortium members.
- 3. On August 6, 2008, the Council passed Ordinance No. 182085 authorizing execution of an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with Metro for the City to obtain LiDAR data. On September 5, 2008, the City executed IGA No. 41241 with Metro for the purchase of LiDAR Data.
- 4. The City wishes to obtain a new set of LiDAR data from Metro through execution of a new IGA which will permit Metro to provide the data and products and to invoice the City for its prorated share of the data and products. A new IGA will enable the City to obtain a current, uniform high resolution set of LiDAR data set for the region and will complete the annual update of aerial photography. This data is used for the identification of landslides, earthquake faults, and storm water modelling as well as updating a number or other key datasets needed for planning and asset management.
- 5. BTS is collaborating with the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), the Water Bureau, and the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) to fund this effort in FY 2014-15. The costs will be partially covered by the Mayor's innovation fund and Water is providing funding to include the Bull Run area in the data collection area.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City's Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement, provided it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney, to acquire LiDAR data and related products from Metro for a total not-to-exceed value of \$280,000.00.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City needs to act promptly to ensure continuity of data availability and to ensure the City's participation in the aerial survey

which will take place in July 2014 for acquisition of data. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
