Yes. The City Council approved Ordinance No. 184849 on September 7, 2011 that authorized a grant funding that covered the total anticipated cost for engineering and right-of-way of the project, estimated at approximately \$1,500,286.00. This Intergovernmental Agreement will add an extra \$1,660,714 in federal funds and an additional \$200,000 in regional Funds for a total of \$1,860,714.
