ORDINANCE No. 186726

* Authorize the allocation of \$8,600 to extend Portland Parks & Recreation free summer lunch program between August 25th and August 29th at 11 sites (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. More than half of the public school children in greater Portland qualify for the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch program, with some schools having rates as high as 90%. Portland Parks & Recreation's (PP&R) free summer lunch program provides more than half of the USDA summer lunches in Portland.
- 2. The summer lunch program is scheduled to end on Friday, August 22nd. School starts on Tuesday, September 2nd for Portland Public Schools (PPS), and Thursday, September 4th for the Centennial and David Douglas School Districts. This leaves a five day gap in service for PPS and a seven day gap for the other two districts.
- 3. This gap in the PP&R summer lunch program at 11 sites around Portland between August 25th and August 29th can be addressed with an increase in appropriation of \$8,600.

The 11 sites where PP&R would extend the free summer lunch program include:

Charles Jordan Community Center

Matt Dishman Community Center

Montavilla Park

Peninsula Park

Mt. Scott Park

Gilbert Primary Park

Lincoln Park

Raymond Park

Ventura Park

Argay Park

Wilkes Park

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City Budget Office to appropriate \$8,600 from General Fund contingency to Portland Parks & Recreation in the FY 2014-15 Fall Budget Monitoring Process to provide free summer lunches to children at 11 sites around Portland between August 25th and August 29th.
- b. The City Budget Office to increase Portland Parks & Recreation's ongoing current appropriation level by \$8,600 beginning in FY 2015-16 to provide free summer lunches to children at 11 sites around Portland on an ongoing basis.

c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to provide payment in the amount of \$8,600, chargeable to the applicable budgets when demand is presented and approved by the appropriate authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in closing the gap in service for Portland Parks & Recreation's free summer lunch program; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
