7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Bureau of Transportation requested a review of the Electrical Supervisor classification due to the classification's new requirements to oversee contractors and electrical capital improvement projects. The Bureau of Human Resources (BHR) reviewed the request and determined the classification specification needed to be revised. BHR also reviewed the compensation level of the classification and is recommending the salary range of this class be changed from Nonrepresented salary range 7 to 8 effective July 1, 2014. This is an emergency ordinance so that this compensation action can be made effective without delay.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The annual maximum rate for this classification is currently \$86,154. This ordinance will raise the annual maximum rate to \$90,605, an increase of \$4,451. There is one regular Electrical Supervisor position in the budget and it is currently vacant.
