\*Amend Cooperative Agreement with the Oregon State Marine Board to restrict nighttime use of the Duckworth Dock except on certain days for a trial period of one year (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 50925)

### 2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The purpose of the proposed legislation is to amend the City's agreement with the Oregon State Marine Board by adding a provision restricting nighttime use of the Duckworth Dock, except for weekends during the summer. This restriction is anticipated to encourage more day-use of this public recreational boat tie-up by recreational boaters. In addition, the nighttime use restriction, which is supported by the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) and Portland Parks & Recreation, is essential for the MCSO River Patrol to provide enforcement by at the Dock.
