## ORDINANCE No. 186757 As Amended

Authorize contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Lower Slough Refugia Habitat Enhancement Project, BES Project # E10176 for \$2,016,000 (Ordinance)

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for constructing 35 large wood debris structures which will provide refugia habitat for native fish species.
- 2. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of labor and materials to construct this project.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$2,016,000, \$200,000 of which will come from a grant from Oregon DEQ Natural Resource Damages Fund. The balance of the funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10176.C60.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
