

ORDINANCE No. 186762

Accept a \$459 donation from Sears Hometown and Outlet Store to purchase equipment and for other needed resources and programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Sears Hometown and Outlet Store, via the National Volunteer Fire Council, raised \$459 during their holiday Salute to Local Heroes charity campaign.
2. These funds are to be used towards protective gear/rescue equipment, certifications and training, assistance and family support for injured responders, building maintenance and refurbishments, recruitment programs and other needed resources and programs for Portland Fire & Rescue.
3. The value of the donation is \$459.
4. The Fire Chief recommends that the Council accept the donation from Sears Hometown and Outlet Store.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City Council accepts the donation of \$459 from Sears Hometown and Outlet Store for the purchase of protective gear/rescue equipment, certifications and training, assistance and family support for injured responders, building maintenance and refurbishments, recruitment programs and other needed resources and programs for Portland Fire & Rescue and thanks Sears Hometown and Outlet Store for its donation.


