The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of continuing professional engineering services provided by Brown and Caldwell, Inc. (BC) for the Alder pump station upgrade, Project E10359.
- 2. BC is continuing to provide professional engineering services under contract No. 30003063 effective November 16, 2012 with an expiration date of October 9, 2017.
- 3. The estimated cost of this contract amendment is \$352,329. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget for Project E10359. The level of confidence in the negotiated cost for the proposed amendment 2 to contract No. 30003063 with BC is high.
- 4. M/W/ESB participation after the authorization of contract amendment 2 will be \$234,689, 33.1% of the amended contract amount of \$710,022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract amendment with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$352,329.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
