

ORDINANCE No. 186768

*Authorize application to Oregon Business Development Department for a grant in the amount of \$20,320 for Brownfield Project Assessment (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. OBDD has grant funding available for brownfield cleanup.
2. BES is preparing a grant application to submit to OBDD requesting funds in the amount of \$20,320 for completion of brownfield cleanup planning activities on the Schultz property, a contaminated and undeveloped privately-owned site located in outer east Portland.
3. Local match of \$5,080 will be provided by the prospective purchaser of the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to OBDD for a grant in the amount of \$20,320.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since a delay would unnecessarily delay the project schedule, potentially compromising this Brownfield Redevelopment opportunity. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


