## ORDINANCE No.

\* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$265,982 from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management Federal Emergency Management Agency Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program for an update of the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is a city-wide strategy to reduce the City's vulnerability to natural hazards. It outlines management actions, regulatory strategies, and capital investments to reduce risks and improve resilience. Projects outlined in the plan are eligible for pre-disaster mitigation grants from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The City's current plan will expire in 2015.
- 2. Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) applied to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program for a grant in the amount of \$240,000 for the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan on October 17, 2013.
- 3. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has notified the City of Portland that it will award a FEMA grant for the City of Portland Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan to PBEM in the amount of \$265,982. The total estimated project cost associated with this grant is \$385,482.
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$119,500 (31%) will be provided by funds from FY2014-15 PBEM program budget appropriations; and in-kind contributions in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY2014-15 budgets of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Office of Equity and Human Rights, and the Bureau of Environmental Services.
- 5. Oregon Emergency Management will administer the Pre-Disaster Mitigation program and reimburse any eligible costs for the project to the City which are identified in the Scope of Work and approved by OEM and FEMA.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a FEMA grant from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan in the amount of \$265,982 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:

**GRANTS FUND** 

Fund - 217

Business Area – EM

Bureau Program Expenses – \$265,982

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of PBEM of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for FEMA Natural Hazard Mitigation Program grant, award number PDMC-PL-10-OR-2013-003, EMS-2014-PC-005, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
