Bureau of Planning and Sustainability staff will brief the Design Commission on the Draft Stakeholder Advisory Committee West Quadrant Plan on Thursday, June 19. This project is a key part of a multi-part 5+ year effort to update the 1988 Central City Plan and is examining a comprehensive range of land use, urban design, transportation, environmental and economic development issues in the western areas of the Central City. The plan area covers the Pearl District, Old Town/Chinatown, Downtown, the West End, Goose Hollow, South Downtown/University District and South Waterfront.
