Extend term of a franchise granted to MCI Metro Access

Transmission Services, Inc. to build and operate telecommunication facilities within City streets (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 169230)

Requested Placement Date: Consent Agenda on August 27, 2014

- Ι. RECOMMENDATION. The Office for Community Technology recommend that Council approve the extension of MCI Metro Access Transmission Services, Inc. continuously and without interruption to December 31, 2014.
- II. BACKGROUND. On October 26, 2011, the City Council adopted non-emergency Ordinance No. 184957, amending Title 17 of the Portland City Code. Among other matters, the ordinance updated, clarified and reorganized various code sections. The City is implementing various aspects of the revised code provisions, and City staff has begun negotiating a renewal agreement, including revised standardized franchise language to address the code amendments. Although franchise negotiations for a renewal agreement are in progress, parties have not agreed on all terms. City staff recommends that the City Council extend the existing franchise to allow time for parties to complete negotiations for a new agreement and to formally complete the formal Portland City Charter procedure for proposed franchises, which can take up to four months or more from the date of the required initial publication.
- Ш. FINANCIAL IMPACT. The City will continue to receive franchise fees. This revenue is intended for the general fund and is not new revenue.
