

ORDINANCE No. 186789

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for shadow train streetcar service to and from the Cooperative Life Sciences Building (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland State University (PSU) is a partner in the Cooperative Life Sciences Building (CLSB) in South Waterfront.
2. Beginning in September 2014, PSU will send a significant number of students to South Waterfront for academic activities at the CLSB.
3. Once the Portland Milwaukie Light Rail line is operational in September 2015, this will provide a connection to South Waterfront from PSU.
4. For the next academic school year PSU students accessing South Waterfront will strain the existing streetcar service.
5. PSU wishes to obtain additional transit services to meet its academic needs and increase the capacity on the streetcar service to South Waterfront until light rail service commences.
6. Portland Streetcar has the ability to add a "shadow" train to increase capacity between PSU and South Waterfront.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University, in a form similar to the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the academic school year and the increased capacity is needed in September 2014; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




