ORDINANCE No. 186789

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for shadow train streetcar service to and from the Cooperative Life Sciences Building (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland State University (PSU) is a partner in the Cooperative Life Sciences Building (CLSB) in South Waterfront.
- 2. Beginning in September 2014, PSU will send a significant number of students to South Waterfront for academic activities at the CLSB.
- 3. Once the Portland Milwaukie Light Rail line is operational in September 2015, this will provide a connection to South Waterfront from PSU.
- 4. For the next academic school year PSU students accessing South Waterfront will strain the existing streetcar service.
- 5. PSU wishes to obtain additional transit services to meet its academic needs and increase the capacity on the streetcar service to South Waterfront until light rail service commences.
- 6. Portland Streetcar has the ability to add a "shadow" train to increase capacity between PSU and South Waterfront.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University, in a form similar to the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the academic school year and the increased capacity is needed in September 2014; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
