7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

In 1970, the City of Portland flag was adopted into City Code. In 2002, City Council modified the design of the flag by removing the City seal, changing the background color of the top left hand section to green, doubling the width of the blue stripes, and enlarging the central star to nine times its initial size. The dimensions adopted in 2002 for the four background sections of the flag were incorrectly stated because they do not equal the total height of the flag. Additionally, the flag color specifications adopted in 2002 are based on a color system that has been out of date since 1996. City Code related to the flag also describes a transition period ending on December 31, 2004 during which both the 1970 flag and the 2002 flag were considered valid official City flags.

This Ordinance will make it easier to reproduce the flag and increase its usability by amending Code to correct the flag's measurements and update the flag's color specifications to a modern color key system. This Ordinance also deletes outdated and unnecessary language from City Code related to the expired transition period between flags.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact in amending City Code to modify and update the City's adopted flag design.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

The CAO recommends that Council adopt the ordinance to amend City Code.
