This amendment to the contract adds services for the contractor to develop a methodology based on investment per capita instead of level of service. This methodology is a divergent approach that should provide a reasonable, fair, and defensible Park SDC fee and capital plan. The services described in the tasks below are additional services to be performed by the Contractor. Portland Parks and Recreation proposes to engage the Contractor for the following additional services.

Contractor will evaluate City policies concerning higher education and campus housing. Contractor will evaluate study submitted by the Home Builders Association concerning relationship of housing size to SDCs and taxes. Contractor will prepare final policy memoranda to be submitted to City Council.

G. Capital Facilities Plan.

Contractor will prepare the capital facilities plan to be consistent with the new methodology based on investment per capita.

I. Funding / Financing Strategy.

Contractor will assist the City to revise estimates of non-SDC revenue to be consistent with the new methodology based on investment per capita.
