

# ORDINANCE No. 186815

\*Accept a \$40,000 grant from the Oregon Department of Education and authorize a price agreement with Centennial School District for the Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Parks & Recreation is a sponsor of an Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program, which allows the Bureau to receive federal reimbursement for costs associated with serving nutritious meals and snacks to children attending afterschool programs in neighborhoods where hunger and food insecurity are prevalent.
2. The Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program is administered by the Oregon Department of Education, which requires sponsors to annually renew their sponsorship agreements, in order to be eligible to receive federal reimbursement.
3. Portland Parks & Recreation has been a program sponsor since 2010, and served more than 23,000 meals. Charles Jordan, St. Johns and Peninsula Park Community Centers are participating in the program for the 2014-15 school year.
4. Portland Parks & Recreation purchases meals for this program from Centennial School District, via a vended meal price agreement.
5. The meal program budget for 2014-2015 is \$43,000, with \$40,000 projected in federal reimbursement.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant in the amount of \$40,000 from the Oregon Department of Education for the Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program.
- b. The Portland Parks & Recreation Director is hereby authorized to enter into a vended meal price agreement with Centennial School District, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- c. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – PK00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$40,000

- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the current contract expires on September 30, 2014; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
