## ORDINANCE No. 186817

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for the Lower Columbia Slough Refugia Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) applied to DEQ for a grant in the amount of \$250,000 for the Lower Columbia Slough Refugia Project on March 7, 2013; and
- DEO has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Lower Columbia Slough Refugia 2. Project to the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) in the amount of \$200,000.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the DEQ for the Lower Columbia Slough Refugia Project in the amount of \$200,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by DEQ for the Lower Columbia Slough Refugia Project grant, award number DEQ-OPSR-NWR-14-10, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council
