

ORDINANCE No. 186818

*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$20,320 from Oregon Business Development Department for brownfield project cleanup planning (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) applied to Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) for a grant in the amount of \$20,320 for the completion of brownfield cleanup planning activities on the Schultz property, a contaminated and undeveloped privately-owned site located in outer east Portland; and
2. OBDD has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for brownfield cleanup planning activities on the Schultz property to BES in the amount of \$20,320; and
3. Local match of \$5,080 will be provided by the prospective purchaser of the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the OBDD for brownfield cleanup planning activities on the Schultz property in the amount of \$20,320 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:
GRANTS FUND
Fund 217
Business Area – ES
Bureau Program Expenses– \$20,320
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of BES of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by OBDD for brownfield cleanup grant for planning activities on the Schultz property, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
