## TO THE COUNCIL:

The UIC Category 3 Retrofit Project will bring the City's underground injection controls (UICs) into compliance with the permit issued by the Department of Environmental Equality (DEQ Permit #102830). The Retrofit Project involves the construction of sediment manholes, sumps and green street facilities within the right of way. Work under this Project to include erosion control measures, constructing sedimentation manholes, sump shallowing and green street facilities throughout east Portland.

Ordinance Number 186695 adopted June 25, 2014 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the UIC Category 3 Retrofit Project. In August, 2014, the Chief Procurement Officer advertised and received bids for Bid Number 117184 for the Underground Injection Controls (UIC) Category 3 Retrofit Project for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of \$870,000.00. The Bureau of Environmental Services rated the project estimate confidence level as Optimal.

Bids were opened on September 11, 2014, and four (4) bids were received. The low bid of Titan Utilities, LLC was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation, and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$1,187,175.00.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified five (5) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project resulting in \$1,187,175.00 of the total subcontracting and contract dollars.

MWESB participation represents 100% or \$187,175.00 of the estimated subcontracting and contract dollars.

- MBE \$51,000.00 performing Concrete Cutting and Concrete Work
- WBE \$55,000.00 performing Hauling Services
- ESB \$1,081,175.00 performing Asphalt Paving, Sewer, Water & Storm Drain Work and Traffic Control – (Prime Contractor)

Titan Utilities, LLC is located in Beaverton, OR and is a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and their EEO Certification is current through October 11, 2015 and is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014/2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10570.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
