Authorize the City Attorney to institute legal proceedings against the Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 483, LIUNA Local 483 to recover unreimbursed union-paid leave (Resolution)

WHEREAS LIUNA Local 483 owes the City over \$81,162.33 in unreimbursed union-paid union leave for the period June 11, 2009 through September 11, 2012 , and

WHEREAS the City has attempted to secure reimbursement of these expenses from LIUNA 483 and has expressed its willingness to discuss repayment options, and

WHEREAS all other labor organizations in the City having agreed to reimburse to City for their share of the same expenses, and

WHEREAS LIUNA Local 483 have to date refused to reimburse the City for these expenses despite a legal obligation to do so,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Portland City Council hereby authorizes the City Attorney or her designee to institute such legal proceedings to recover unreimbursed union-paid leave from LIUNA Local 483 as she deems necessary and appropriate.
